ABSTRACT

English Village in Pare District, Kediri City, has great potential as an English language education center, but supporting facilities such as accommodation, places to eat, and public spaces are still limited. With the increasing number of visitors, the need for a Food Court and Communal Space is increasingly important. The Food Court is expected to support the local economy through MSMEs, while the Communal Space becomes a place for students and the community to collaborate and deepen their English language skills. This planning aims to improve the quality of life of the local community while strengthening the position of the English Village as a dynamic and inclusive foreign language education destination. This plan is also in line with the area order program that has been prepared by the Kediri BAPEDA Service, in order to create a more orderly and beneficial environment for all parties, especially in the English Village. The output of this planning is the establishment of a Food Court (Snack Center) and Communal Space in the English Village area, which consists of four main buildings and one supporting building. The two main buildings will function as a one-story Communal Space for students to have discussions, complete assignments, and other educational activities. The other two buildings will be a two-story Food Court, which provides traditional and contemporary food and drinks that are difficult to find there. This Food Court aims to meet the needs of culinary variety for the community and students, as well as provide an atmosphere that can help refresh the minds of students during learning. And one supporting building will be used for building management.
