HKBP Cibinong Church is a Protestant Christian church based on the Batak ethnicity which is located at Jl. H. R. Lukman, Cirimekar, Cibinong, Bogor. This church was founded in 1966, but at that time worship activities were still being carried out in the congregation's house at the Palad Cibinong hostel. Then in 1973 the church building began to be built. And until now the church building has never undergone renovation, so that the church building is no longer able to accommodate the growth rate of the congregation that has been increasing.

In connection with this problem, a plan emerged for the construction of a new building for the HKBP Cibinong Church with the aim of being able to meet the space requirements that have so far not been in line with the growth rate of the congregation and also the construction of church facilities to support worship activities at the church.

Archipelago architecture is the theme chosen in the design of the church building this time. Archipelago architecture is a form of culture that has a functional dimension as a container. In its design, the implementation of the theme of the building will appear on the facade of the building which will be dominated by elements of Batak culture, building structures, and also building materials.
