The objectives of this research are to find out what and how narrative functions and sphere of actions occurs in the novel *It Ends with Us* by Colleen Hoover which was published in 2016. The research used qualitative method. In doing so, the research employs narrative functions and sphere of actions theories as tools of analysis. The result of the research found 12 out of 31 narrative function which includes: the initial situation, absentation, interdiction, violation, delivery, villainy, departure, returns, complicity, struggle, exposure and punishment. The most dominant functions are interdiction, violation, and villainy with each has 2 data. For the result of sphere of actions, the researcher found 3 out of 7 sphere of action which include; the hero, the villain and the false hero. The most dominant character functions are the villain and the hero with each has 3 data. The narrative functions and sphere of actions show through the form of monologue and dialogue.
