Abstract

It is important to the authors of a movie to include some aspects like psychologicalaspect in order to give insight to the audience. One of psychological aspect that canbe contained in a movie is hierarchy of needs. Abraham Maslow explained that there are five levels in hierarchy of needs namely, physiological needs, safety needs, love needs, esteem needs, self-actualization needs. This research focuses on the Natascha Kampusch's as a main character in 3096 Days Movie by using AbrahamMaslow's theory. It uses qualitative research method to describe the related data. The data was taken from dialogue and body language.
