Epithet followed classifier and thing, (7). Epithet followed by classifier, thing and qualifier, (8). Classifier followed by thing and qualifier, (9). Thing followed by qualifier, (10). Classifier followed by thing, (11). Deictic followed by numerative, thing and qualifier, (12). Numerative followed by epithet, classifier, thing and qualifier.
