

***THE RELATIONSHIP OF SELF-DISCLOSURE AND FRIENDSHIP
INTIMACY IN STUDENTS OF THE FACULTY OF PSYCHOLOGY,
GUNADARMA UNIVERSITY***

ABSTRACT

The aim of this research is to examine the relationship between self-disclosure and friendship intimacy among students at the psychology faculty at Gunadarma University. This research is quantitative in nature using the research dimensions of the friendship intimacy scale proposed by Leung and the self-disclosure scale proposed by Sharabany. The total sample for this research was 115 respondents. The sampling technique used in this research was purposive sampling and data analysis using the Pearson product moment correlation technique with the help of a computer program, namely IBM SPSS Statistics 22. Based on the correlation test, there is a positive relationship between self-disclosure and friendship intimacy among students at the psychology faculty of Gunadarma University, where the higher the self-disclosure, the higher the friendship intimacy. The correlation value obtained was 0.684 and the significance value was 0.000 ($p < 0.01$).
