Entmen's framing analysis with four tools, namely, defining the problem, the cause of the problem (diagnosing causes), making moral decisions (make moral judgment) and emphasizing the solution (treatment recommendation). The results of this study indicate that in framing the reporting of the Pony orangutan exploitation case on the online media Kompas.com, the news presented on the online.com media looks very real and actually happened, not too big of a problem to attract the public to read the news content.
