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This study aims to determine power relations in the film Jagal: The Act Of Killing through the semiotics meaning of Roland Barthes, this research uses a qualitative-interpretative. Data collection techniques are carried out by selecting 5 scene that contain power relations, on scene 1 shows the method of killing victims using wire this shows that there is a higher power between Pancasila Youth and communism. On scene 2 there is a power relation between newspaper publisher and Pancasila Youth which cooperates in arresting and killing communist, in scene 3 the head of the local paramilitary is seen coming to the ethnic Chinese market seller to blackmail them without any opportunity for the seller to object or revolt. On scene 4 shows several paramilitary members telling how they used to rape underage children and burn down people's houses, finally in scene 5 is the statement of one of the killers form Pancasila Youth whos doesn't feel guilty for killing hundreds of victims and he is proud to be member of Pancasila Youth.
