ANALYSIS OF ENTMAN'S FRAMING IN THE NEWS OF THE MK DECISION ON AGE LIMIT FOR PRESIDENTIAL AND VICE PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES ON THE NEWS PORTAL CNNINDONESIA.COM

Ahead of the 2024 elections, there are various phenomena related to democratic parties, one of which is that there is an amendment to article 169 letter q of the Election Law that discusses the minimum age limit for presidential and vice presidential candidates, where the minimum age limit for presidential and vice presidential candidates before the change in the rule is 40 years old. The change also reaped various criticisms from various parties and became a controversial discussion. This study aims to find out how Entman's framing analysis on the news of the Constitutional Court's decision regarding the age limit for presidential and vice presidential candidates on the CNNIndonesia.com news portal for the period 11–17 October 2023 using the Spiral of Silence Theory. This study uses a qualitative approach method with the Robert N. Entman framing analysis model. The four aspects in Entman's framing analysis include defining problems, diagnosing causes, making moral judgments, and making treatment recommendations. The research paradigm used in this study is the constructivism paradigm, and the data collection methods used include observation, documentation, and literature studies. The results of this study show that CNNIndonesia.com frames the news of the Constitutional Court's decision on the age limit for presidential and vice presidential candidates with a counter attitude, which can influence the audience's perspective to adopt a similar view or be reluctant to support the Constitutional Court's decision, especially if this counter view is more socially accepted. This proves the connection with the Spiral of Silence Theory.
