validity test and reliability test. The model used in this survey refers to the

updated Delone and McLean Information System Success Model. The goal of this

research on the SIAKAD project is to understand the impact of variable system

quality (system quality), information quality (information quality), and service

quality (service quality) on user satisfaction (user satisfaction). The results of this

study indicate that the quality of the system, the quality of information and the

quality of service have a positive and significant effect on the satisfaction of

SIAKAD STMIK Bani Saleh users.
